

The Resolve® system





Resolve takes the essential concepts of systems furniture and starts again.

There are no panels, no cubicles, and no separate connectors. Instead, Resolve's design begins with a simple central element: a steel pole. In fact, Resolve is the world's first pole-based furniture system. Horizontal arms attach directly to the poles at 120-degree angles to create honeycomb-like organic patterns of workstations with two, three, four, or five sides.

Resolve uses less to do more for an organisation and its people; every element is engineered to perform efficiently and yield significant savings.

It's a big change from the usual—and it's easy. Just install Resolve and watch it perform.







Get the most from your space

Resolve uses 120-degree angles to form the richest possible concentration of work areas. It lets designers mix and arrange its 120-degree patterns to create the floor plan that uses square footage most efficiently while keeping the space open and inviting.

With three-sided poles providing more connection points than panels, Resolve allows denser layouts than 90-degree products. And since there are no panels, there's no panel thickness to account for in planning.

Add it up, and a Resolve installation can take up less floor space as it provides comfortable places for people to work.






Simplify change

Change comes naturally to Resolve. Its lean, light architecture is easy to handle. Its efficient vocabulary of parts—about a quarter of the size of traditional furniture systems and a third of the weight—takes less time to install and change and is simpler to manage.

To divide space efficiently, Resolve screens attach quickly to upper and lower support arms. To refresh the look of a space economically, screens can be changed without disrupting workers. Screens can also be digitally printed with any image so they're unique to your company, brand and culture.

Above, right: two workstations with custom-printed screen images. Below, right: the same space with different screens and a new function without changing the structure.






Carry the technology load

Resolve handles all the electronic equipment people need to be their most productive. It also lets an organisation implement the most efficient and cost-effective means of power and data delivery.

Power and data can enter from the floor, wall, or ceiling. Cables and conduits can be distributed within Resolve's overhead trusses or along its lower support arms. Zone distribution cabinets reduce the costs of installing and reconfiguring data cabling. Used alone or in combination, these distribution choices provide flexibility and low-cost upgrading and change.

Power and data in a raised floor can be distributed along power/data channels on lower support arms, which are 330 millimetres off the floor to allow easy access to raised floor tiles—and to let air circulate.





Take the direct route

Resolve's overhead trusses distribute power and data on the most direct paths between poles and between workstation clusters, minimising the amount of cable used.

Trusses are independent of the workstations below so workstations can change without disconnecting networks, and power and data can change without interrupting people. Cables and conduits are simply laid into the open trusses for easy installation and change.

Power and data entering from the ceiling can be distributed in trusses. Cables are routed from trusses along the outside of pole faces to feed data ports and to make change easier. Electrical harnesses come installed inside powered poles.






Help people work effectively

Resolve begins with the individual in mind, creating spaces that help each person work comfortably and productively. Its light architecture and 120-degree structure create open, accessible, welcoming workstations.

Quiet Technology™ sound masking attaches to tall poles and makes speech beyond a four-to-five-metre radius unintelligible so people can concentrate and still collaborate with nearby colleagues.

Resolve provides the territory and tools needed to get things done. The work area shown above left transforms easily from a collaborative space to individual workstations (below left), providing visual privacy with the simple addition of support arms and screens.



Put everything within reach

Resolve's human scale makes the work area an extension of the self. Curved boomerang work surfaces keep materials in arm's reach. People can position work tools to best suit the work process. When employees feel comfortable and in control, they're more productive—and it's easier to attract and retain them.





Encourage collaboration

The translucency and openness of Resolve promotes teamwork, communication, and collaboration. Resolve allows natural light to flood the workplace—a proven factor in maintaining high levels of employee morale and productivity.



Resolve designer Ayse Birel is principal of Olive 1:1, a design consultancy. She has won numerous design awards, and her work is included in the permanent collection of the Museum of Modern Art.

Resolve is almost 90 percent recyclable and is easily disassembled for recycling. A typical Resolve workstation has 27 percent recycled content.

Resolve is durable for a long life and carries a comprehensive 12-year, 3-shift warranty.
