

The main body of the busby chair is constructed with a birch plywood internal frame and CMHR foams.


*All dimensions quoted are rounded to the nearest 5mm or nearest 1/2 inch.






Busby internal frame is constructed by hand from hardwood and CMHR foams. The loose bolster and scatter cushions are feather and synthetic fibre filled.
